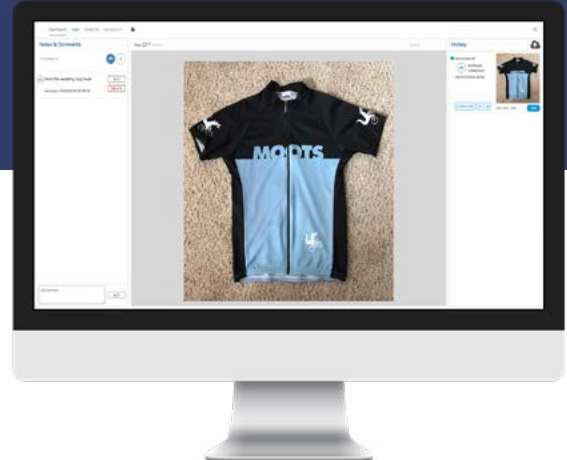

OVERVIEW

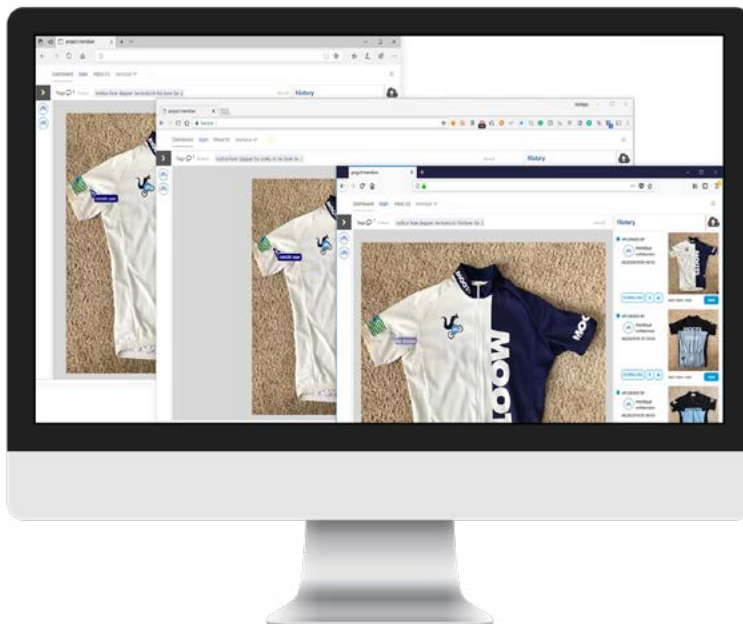
Built with freelance designers in mind, Meridian provides a simple way to finalize designs. Often, the approval process involves the client making changes on the design in an image editing program they use regularly, and emailing the edits to the designer in their format. Meridian solves these problems by keeping this process online where designs can be easily tagged, edited, and shared in a single format.

TECHNOLOGIES USED

Angular 4, Amazon AWS (S3, EC2, Cloudwatch, Cognito), MongoDB, signalR, OWIN Self-Hosted WebApi, Microservice Architecture, C#, Typescript, JavaScript, EvoPdf, CSS



The designer uploads the design and sends the URL to the client for editing.

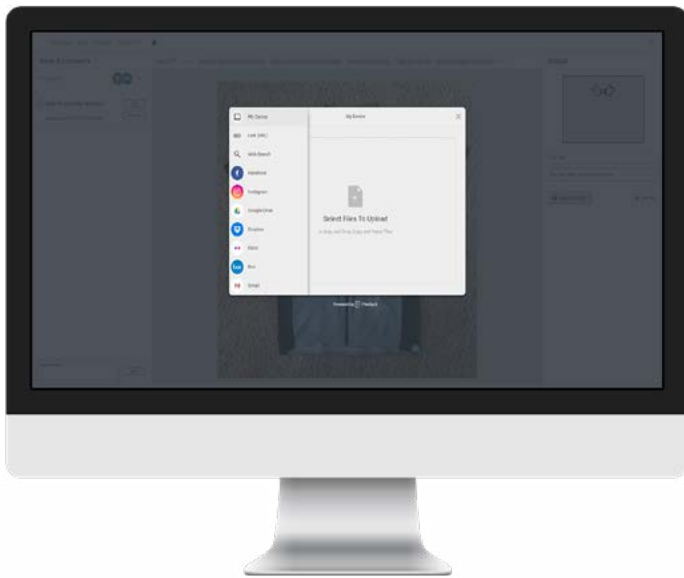


The editor and designer use the cross-browser “peer-to-peer” feature to switch designs and guide discussions. In this way, clients and designers sync up on the same page in real-time.

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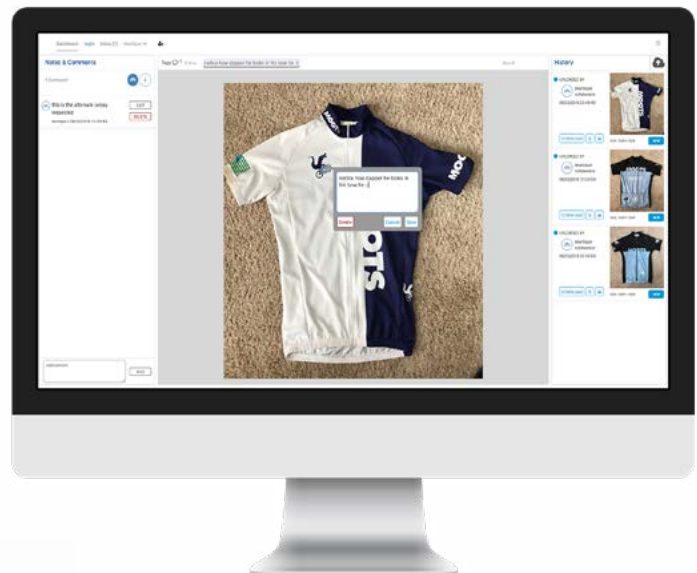
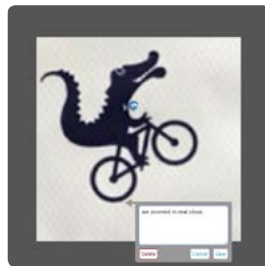




Upload designs in supported formats such as .jpg, .png, and .pdf.



Users can place tags directly onto the design. The “zoom” feature allows for precise tag placement.
